A Message from the UAW Organizing Committee at Volkswagen, Chattanooga



To our coworkers:

Now that a majority of Volkswagen Chattanooga workers have signed union authorization cards, what are the next steps in forming our union?

There is a legally protected process for forming a union. The first step is signing union authorization cards that say Volkswagen workers want to form a union and collectively bargain with VW. Once enough cards have been signed, we can file for an election with the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB). The NLRB will then schedule an election, and if a majority of us vote to form a union, VW will be legally required to begin negotiating with us, as equals. We want Volkswagen and our community to thrive, and having a voice at work will help make that happen.

We will file for an election once 70% of VW workers at Chattanooga have signed authorization cards. Make sure you join the majority and sign today. (Scan QR code on the back)

We will win that election with participation from every line and every shift.
