## ON DAIMLER NEGOTIATIONS

### Greetings from your Local 5286 Bargaining Committee.

After a three-week break, the Company finally returned to local bargaining in an evening session that followed Common Table bargaining. During this session, we passed two proposals, one on hours and overtime and the other on skilled trades (Article 33) with Brother Payseur giving a detailed explanation of the significant issues in skilled trades at Gastonia and your Bargaining Committee's more than reasonable proposals to solve the issues. The Company passed back five proposals.

Overall, there is some modest movement from the Company, and other than skilled trades - which is going to be a battle - we are confident that over the course of the next few days of bargaining, we can come to an agreement on the improvements we are demanding in the local language.

We are pleased to report that we were able to achieve a tentative agreement on significant improvements to Article 19 outsourcing.
