ON DAIMLER NEGOTIATIONS

UAW Local 5286 Family,

Your Gastonia Bargaining Committee met in evening sessions last night and tonight and continued to work towards improvements — with no concessions — in your local contract language.

Bargaining has been focused on both Skilled Trades and production, and we are moving closer to an agreement on significant improvements in job security language by way of a fifty-five percent (55%) increase in a commitment to invest in the plant, an agreement on the return of corporate-controlled parts before there is any layoff within the plant, and an agreement on equitable distribution of holiday overtime.

Tonight, we focused on Skilled Trades with Brother Parsour having the patience to school the Company on why our demanded improvements in Article 33 are essential to getting this deal done.
