UAW Daimler Family,

Your DTNA Bargaining Council met with the Company throughout Friday, from early morning until midnight Friday night, and then again Saturday morning until 5 pm, when the Company asked for a break. We return to the table today at 1 pm.

Over the course of these last two days of bargaining, the Union has passed and hard bargained on every one of your demands, and as we stand right now, Sunday morning, it's all in the Company's hands. While we have achieved some significant improvements in the last two days in things like improving the definition of days worked during probation, increased bereavement time, and orientation time, among the many other improvements we have reported over the last two weeks both on the Local and Common level, the reality is the Company has yet to come to the table to acknowledge that we will not bring back a deal unless it includes:

- historic wage increases
- profit sharing
