

MAIN TABLE BARGAINING UPDATE

ON DAIMLER NEGOTIATIONS

UAW Daimler Family,

By all appearances, after 14 more hours of sitting and waiting, the company has no interest in coming to an agreement. Nearly all of the time spent bargaining was with Brother Mike Crowe, in a small room, discussing the Memphis PDC where the employer panicked over the expectation that workers at the PDC in Memphis (150 members of 7,300) expect Health and Safety language protections that are more than a page long. The employer is very concerned about how much these proposals will cost.

This is in contrast to the common table, where the employer joined our Union team only twice to make minor movements that do not address our priorities.

The company should be investing all its time and resources in coming to an agreement before all the tics are tocked, but they are intentionally barreling toward a strike.

Are you ready to stand united for the record contract we deserve?
