

TOP COMMUNITY ACTION PROGRAM (CAP) Febraury 2024

Became the first state in decades to repeal a union-restricting law known as "right-to-work" that was passed over a decade ago by a Republicancontrolled Legislature. Retirement tax rollback could return up to \$1,000 to retirees.

The State of MI 80/20 premium cost sharing (healthcare cap). Members are responsible for 20% of their insurance premium cost share for the State PPO plan. If a member chooses a more enriched plan, at a higher cost than the state plan, the member would be responsible for the premium share amount plus the additional cost. Wanting state to contribute more the members healthcare premium cost or at the minimum pay the same percentage for all plans.

Governor Whitmer will be appointing someone to the MI Civil Service Commission, after December 31, 2024.

Senate Bills 165, 166 and 167 – legislation for the hybrid Michigan State Police 2012 Pension Plan has moved to the Full Senate Floor (<u>2023-SFA-0165-G.pdf (mi.gov</u>)). The bills would amend the Michigan State Police 2012 Pension Plan to allow other State Employees with law enforcement responsibilities to be eligible.
