Dear Ms. Barton-Richardson and Ms. Miller:

We, the undersigned 25 elected officials, write to express our support for striking legal staff at CAMBA Legal Services (CLS). The over 50 attorneys, paralegals, and support staff who make up the membership of CAMBA Legal Services Workers United (CLSWU) play a critical role in bridging access to justice gaps by representing low-income New Yorkers in housing, foreclosure, immigration, and consumer matters. Now more than ever, New York relies on our legal services workers to meet an affordability crisis and attacks on due process. We urge the leadership of CAMBA, Inc. and CLS to stay at the table and do whatever is necessary to ensure that members of CLSWU can return to work with a fair and just contract. New Yorkers need them back on the front lines.

We write to urge you to come to the table with CLSWU's Bargaining Committee prepared to engage meaningfully with their key demands. During this bargaining session, CLSWU's demands include:

- A livable wage floor for paralegals;
- A cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) that accurately reflects the crisis of affordability in New York City;
- Competitive compensation for all attorney steps;
- Workload protections for housing staff, in line with a recent <u>Right to Counsel report</u>;
- Leave provisions with 100% pay, including parental leave, short-term disability leave, and sabbatical time.

CAMBA, Inc. is a cornerstone of the New York City community. CLSWU members form the backbone of the important work of CLS. We are confident that we share a desire to provide CLSWU workers with the resources and working conditions they need to continue doing the vital work our city relies on them to perform. We welcome conversations about how we can work together as a community to sustain critical legal services in New York.
